

PARENT AND GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Parents must be courteous at all times to everyone, including coaches, skaters and their fellow parents in accordance with the Skate Canada's Code of Ethics.
- 2. For insurance reasons, Parents/Guardians are not permitted on the ice surface.
- 3. Parents, Guardians or designate should remain in the arena for the entire session.
- 4. Coaches are not to be disturbed during lessons.
- 5. Parents should not be communicating with their child while they are on the ice.
- 6. Parents shall refrain from any behaviour or comments which are profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive.
- Parents shall instill confidence in their child's ability and skill development, avoiding comparisons with other skaters.
- 8. Parents shall celebrate the acquisition of skills and goals achieved by their child.
- 9. Parents, along with the professional coach and the athlete, shall be considered members of a team whose main concern is the child's overall progress and development.
- 10. Parents shall respect that the professional coach is responsible and empowered for the on-ice and office development of the athlete.
- 11. Parents shall ensure their child wears proper skating clothing and equipment.
- 12. Parents shall adhere to the policies, procedures, rules, standards, and ethics of HESC and Skate Canada and our facilities at all times.
- 13. Parents will not use technology or social media to disrespect or exploit others.
- 14. Parents are not allowed to record another child that is not their own unless they have consent from said parent.
- 15. Concerns/Complaints will be reviewed only if submitted in writing to the Board and will be reviewed by the Executive Board.
