



PARENT AND GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Parents must be courteous at all times to everyone, including coaches, skaters and their fellow parents in accordance with the Skate Canada's Code of Ethics.
2. For insurance reasons, Parents/Guardians are not permitted on the ice surface.
3. Parents, Guardians or designate should remain in the arena for the entire session.
4. Coaches are not to be disturbed during lessons.
5. Parents should not be communicating with their child while they are on the ice.
6. Parents shall refrain from any behaviour or comments which are profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive.
7. Parents shall instill confidence in their child's ability and skill development, avoiding comparisons with other skaters.
8. Parents shall celebrate the acquisition of skills and goals achieved by their child.
9. Parents, along with the professional coach and the athlete, shall be considered members of a team whose main concern is the child's overall progress and development.
10. Parents shall respect that the professional coach is responsible and empowered for the on-ice and off-ice development of the athlete.
11. Parents shall ensure their child wears proper skating clothing and equipment.
12. Parents shall adhere to the policies, procedures, rules, standards, and ethics of HESC and Skate Canada and our facilities at all times.
13. Parents will not use technology or social media to disrespect or exploit others.
14. Parents are not allowed to record another child that is not their own unless they have consent from said parent.
15. Concerns/Complaints will be reviewed only if submitted in writing to the Board and will be reviewed by the Executive Board.
